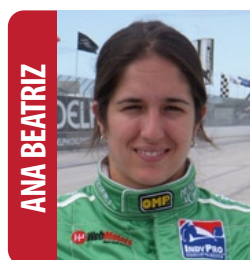




MEET THE 2009 SAM SCHMIDT MOTORSPORTS TEAM
